Creativity is the real need of today's society and educational managersas the powerful muscle of the educational system can deepen the understanding and foster creativity and affect the learning of students. This study which is conducted based on library method with a systematic approach try to identify factors that education director should pay attentions to them for having a creative, dynamic and creativity nurturer school, including organizational culture, management style, identifying the creative community and its impact on that creativity and knowledge and understanding the creative teachers and using of creative teaching methods of educating and its influencing on selecting the teacher, the role of space and equipment, the role of art as an interdisciplinary course, paying attention to proper evaluation and recognition of the family as the most important factor for identifying and fostering creativity and as the manager arm.

Educational Manager is the representative of the macro programming of the country atthe schools and on the other hand due to the powers he had he can affect all human and non-human factors in order to identify and foster creativity and culture learning tolearn and can be

very effective. One of the effective factors is organizational culture. Korkmaz and Arpaci argue that organizational creativity means delivering innovative thinking and new design to improve the quantity or quality of the organization's activities such as increasing productivity, enhancing products or services, reducing costs, products or services by better methods, new products or services and so on. In this respect, organizational culture can play an important role in the creation of organizational behavior and change within the organization. The presence of a creative organizational culture and creative styles in the form of common beliefs and thoughts cancreate a space full of vitality, passion, innovation and ideas. Martinez in his study entitled "Establishing an Organizational Culture Stimulating Creativity and Innovation" came to the conclusion that organizational culture can affect creativity organizations. According to bayat as any amount of organization's culture gets closer to the participatory culture, the higher its creativity and as the creativity of an organization's culture gets closer to the hierarchical culture of the organization, its creativity will be lower. The environments of enterprise in which the spirit of creativity in them is populated have organic pellets because they are committed to human factors and they basically

promotes creativity and innovation efforts and if disciplinary regulations to be seen in them those are according to encouragement to the productive activities. Tabari and Oladzadeh in the investigation entitled as the factors affecting on attraction and retaining of talent in primary schools came to the conclusion that the values and culture of the organization can favorable impact the attraction and retaining of talent in the organization (Mojtaba and Esfandiari, 2016) in their research examined the impact of leadership style and creativity and found that the uncontrolled supportive styleare the important factors affecting creativity and innovation. Other factors that educational manager with special attention to them and creating systematic communication can be effective toward potential talents and students and teachers, space and equipment, society, art and family are also noted in this category that they will be discussed.

He believes that creativity is not a product of an individual unit, at the same time and in a particular place but it is rather the one habitat (ecosystem) in a creative environment that all members and all aspects of the environment interact in it. A society that goes toward the future where people are like the cells of a living organism that has evolved with the development of harmonious look. In the creative community, people every day are faced with new questions and dilemmas and issues. Creative society is a society where people have a deep understanding of the world around them and to solve problems in new ways to benefit from after extensive

research found thatcultural factors, more than any other factor are associated with creativity. She wrote "the greater the size and pleasant of atmosphere the more open the society and people act with greater freedom and a sense of responsibility during an investigation about occasion of the cultural conditions of Behzad area with art and his creativity which are known by these following factors. The favorable economic situation and welfare of people living there. The presence of people who like culture and art in power and their support for art and creativity.

Teacher: The teacher's role as a pillar of the educational system in the prosperity is inclusive of the utmost importance. These flagship of education system can foster creative people who are problem solvers of the today's progressing society and play a significant role in the development of the country.

Research of Pardo showed that teachers who are trained have a significant impact on creative performance, academic achievement and cognitive development of students (Alsadat, 1999). Farooqi and Lipman pointed the education research-project axis and he believes that a research based educational system can boost moral skills such as social tolerance, confidence and true curiosity and fair competition which ispointing to the Cheragh Cheshm pointed to the techniques of brain activity or brain storming, forced association, turnover-fi, nominal group technique and parallel thinking that include role playing, random and reverse link. Professor Lipman about the role of clean power of argument in the lives of people came to the conclusion that many students and even students lack the ability to reason and good judgment are the result of lack of training in their thinking and reasoning in childhood, so a new program entitled education philosophy for children "aims to improve children's reasoning in thinking, design and make it into a school. According to Shabani, telling stories without end or without a title, participating Children in creative drama to the story, illustration and painting focuses on the story are the important factors. Reverse and innovative teaching method sare effective methods to foster creativity and dynami clearning that a teacher can

use them. Mehrnegarbeh quoted from the Institute of Foorozan, refers to Color Psychology that argued the blazing influence of the effects of color on teachers' clothes toward students.

Space and equipment: Paying attention toward the importance of school spaces makes students have a sense of belonging to school because that's where teamwork, social relations, dynamic and forward-thinking learn school space should be standardized and therefore in order to foster creativity and learning bedy namic. Head Master said that the child should be integrated with nature. Natural factors such as soil, light, wind, plants, animal and stimulate the visual sense, hearing, touch and smell and cognitive plays important role in identifying the environment as well as creating a sense of tranquility. Habibi argues that the kind of relationship with nature, existed on past patterns of Iranian architecture in the courtyard garden. Garden creates and reflects non-negligible impact in providing risk environment for teaching and invites visitors to reflect in educational settings in cities (Quoting 22) Pedigree child's creativity needs a harmonious and balanced proportions of architectural events. This helps form a strange environment and creates a new second home for them Mahmoudi states that square and close to the square forms are stable and reassuring and are suitable to place decision-making and pause, circular or curved and circular forms look soft and experience have shown that Kids love forms which are soft and can be used in different spaces of these forms, simple forms, especially symmetrical balance and induce irregular forms and can force children to follow their creativity to stimulate the imagination (Dasti et al., 2016). The classroom should be designed so that teachers can order it to be involved and learners as a group (3 or 4 or 5 people) together to sit together and interact because group raise work creativityandreduce disciplinary problems and pervasive prepare for life more dynamic and more successful.

In a study that Harrison conducted, come to the conclusion that information and communications technology, makes the education deeper and more effective and causes the development of creativity (Puran, 2016). It should be noted that the proper light of class according to time of day and nights and seasons and heating and ventilation conditions should be such that promote the quality and conditions of education and creativity to increase productivity. and mind Azimi believes that the use of bright colors in an educational setting increase specific actions and enhance intellectual and cognitive brain directions, color can affect learning time detection sense, green and tranquil blue color causes the slow estimate of the passage of time and it is proper for the long time classes.

Art: In this hectic and transient world, all people with awareness will benefit of inner peace. Such peace, rooted in self-knowledge and at the same time depends on honoring the creative branch, individuality of each human (Yahya and Narges, 2008) says that the creation of any work of art takes place in the area of creativity. Creativity is an experience, an experience that first place in the mind of an artist, between the conscious and unconscious mind of himself and then arises in a place in the mind of the artist and the audience (Shahram et al., 2010). The administrator can care for interdisciplinary art lesson as a lesson to foster a generation inventive, creative and innovative step. Conti and Amabile found that the competitive assessment has the greatest impact on the creativity of girls (Puran, 2016). The most basic element of dynamic systems is feedback which is rooted in the control and communication. Educational feedback which is the same process that the make learner aware of how is his learning and assist him in correcting his behavior.

According to Fodor and Carver if the evaluation could have feedback effects, especially positive feedback, research has shown that in such a situation, a positive correlation was observed between the succeed creativity and motivation.

Family: Family environmenthas important effect oneducation, learning, understanding and foster creativity in children and adolescents. When students deal learning with a creative approach, their logical thinking, critical and learning power would growdeeper. Rowan argues that the emergence of creativity is closely related with GPS [Quotes 1] Mehrafzastated that there is a significant positive relationship between the family emotional atmosphere amenable to the principles of democracy and creativity [cited 16].

Leslic believes that one of the important characteristics of parents is having the opportunity to encourage-not suppress-curiosity, creativity of the children. Hesays: "Why?" To encourage.

The game is where imagination meets reality Doctor Spock said we should let children free games to manage their affairs and games and able to play to learn necessary knowledge of games they should entrust the optional string of the games into the hands of the children so to do what his imagination says, only in this way that his game would be useful. The results of Gholam Ali and Karim Zade study showed that computer games is significant in reducing the size and extent of the student's originality.

Muzaffar says that the child's exposure to environments and cultures and people and experiences and different ways have caused on the thinking and creativity of them. He also emphasized the doubling of creativity of children in natural, thick and green environments and ask their families to make use of it. Experts suggest to encourage children to storytelling and drawing from their daily experiences.

CONCLUSION

However, individual differences and intrinsic motivation are effective toward organizational creativity but undoubtedly other factors such as knowledgeable and creative leadership, considering human resources and having positive relationships, coordination and compliance interests and talents, can cause the organizational creativity.
